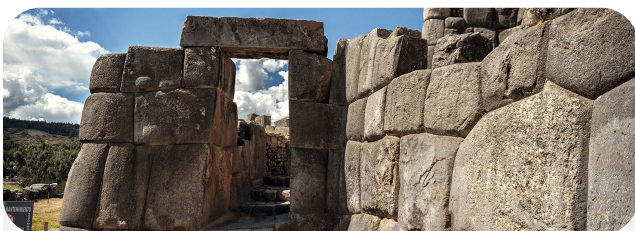

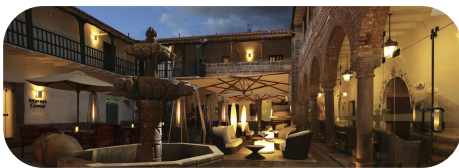

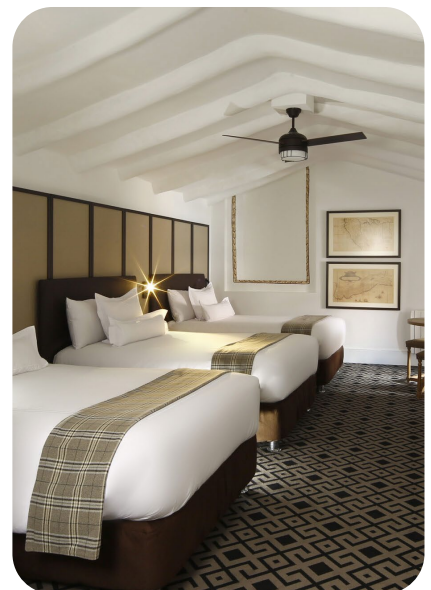

15:00-16:30 | VISIT TO MACHU PICCHU, CIRCUIT 3B

🕒 Duration: 2:30 hrs.

DESCRIPTION:

It is the ideal option for older adults or visitors with reduced mobility, as the route is mostly flat and less physically demanding.

DURATION:

Low difficulty: the easiest and most accessible route. Mostly flat terrain, designed to avoid steep inclines. Recommended for older adults, people with knee issues, or families with young children.



Agricultural Sector:

Entry through the terraces, offering panoramic photo opportunities.

Temple of the Sun:

Sacred semicircular structure.

House of the Inca:

Royal residence with fine stonework.

Ceremonial Fountains:

Channels and cascading sacred water features.

Three Doorways Sector:

A group of residential enclosures.

Temple of the Condor or Water Mirrors:

At the end of the route, visitors may choose to visit one of these two sites before exiting.

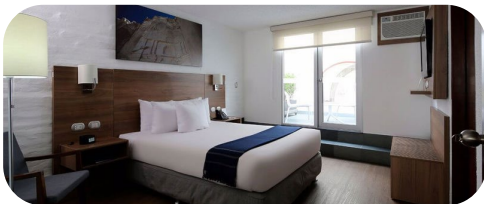

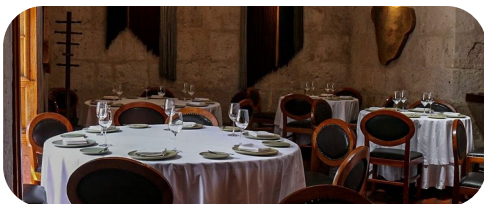

10:30 | TEXTILE AND HANDICRAFT TRADITION TOUR

🕒 Duration: 3 hrs.



During this tour, visitors will explore:

Mundo Alpaca: Guests observe alpacas and llamas while learning about the entire value chain, from fiber classification to traditional backstrap loom weaving.

The experience combines technical and historical learning through the Textile Machinery Museum and the Amano-Michell Pre-Columbian Textile Museum, offering a comprehensive view of the industry's past and present.

The tour concludes at Fundo El Fierro (next to San Francisco Square), where visitors can purchase authentic silverwork, leather goods, and ceramics directly from artisans in a historic setting.

HISTORIC CENTER:

Visit the Plaza de Armas, surrounded by arcades and the impressive Cathedral.



COLONIAL ROUTE:

Visit the churches of La Compañía de Jesús, San Francisco, and Santo Domingo.



SANTA CATALINA MONASTERY:

Renowned for its vibrant cloisters, inner plazas, and valuable collection of Cusco School art.

Signature dishes include meats cooked on volcanic stone (alpaca, beef, lamb, and duck), served with a variety of sauces and side dishes.

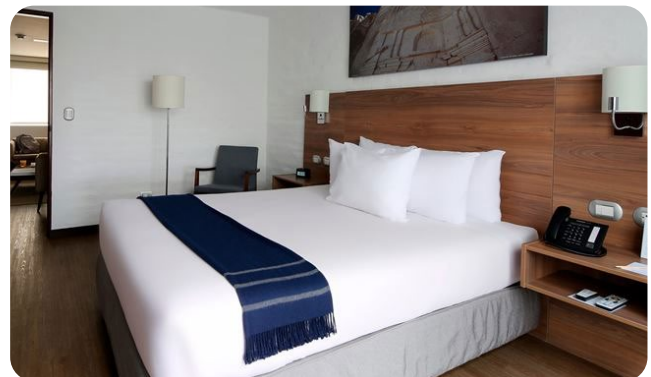

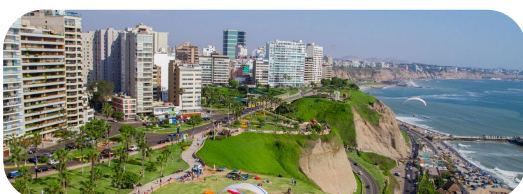
