SUPPLIER REGULATIONS

The purpose of these Regulations is to inform suppliers of the rules, conditions, and provisions applicable to the performance of work at the World Mining Congress 2026, to be held in the city of Lima from June 24 to 26, 2026, a specialized trade fair for the mining sector featuring a technology exhibition (hereinafter, the "EVENT"), organized by the Instituto de Ingenieros de Minas del Perú (Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers), hereinafter referred to as THE IIMP. These Supplier Regulations form an integral part of the agreement signed by THE IIMP and THE EXHIBITOR, under which the latter will exhibit its goods and/or products at the fair. The SUPPLIER contracted by the exhibitor must adhere to this document for the proper conduct of its participation, undertaking to comply with all its provisions; likewise, it must comply with the provisions of the EXHIBITOR REGULATIONS

1.- IIMP

The terms "Institute" or "THE IIMP" used herein refer to the Instituto de Ingenieros de Minas del Perú (the Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers), its offices, or the employees who represent it in organizing the Event.

2.- DATE AND VENUE

The event will take place in Lima from June 24 to 26, 2026, at the Lima Convention Center in the district of San Borja, in the province and department of Lima.

3.- EXHIBITION HOURS

4.- EXHIBITOR

It refers to any individual or legal entity (domestic or foreign) that has entered into an Exhibition Agreement and the Sponsorship and Exhibitor Participation Agreement, as an exhibitor, with THE IIMP for the purpose of obtaining temporary use of a space consisting of one (01) or more exhibition stands (hereinafter "stands").

5.- SUPPLIER

It refers to any individual or legal entity (national or foreign) that has entered into a Services Agreement with THE EXHIBITOR to set up one (1) or more exhibition stands (hereinafter, the "stands")

THE EXHIBITOR shall be jointly and severally liable to the IIMP for the acts or omissions of its suppliers.

6.- THE IIMP'S OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY SUPERVISOR

He/She represents THE IIMP before THE EXHIBITOR and THEIR SUPPLIER. It is the person responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions of Safety at Work and Occupational Health and Safety at Work.



7.- ADMISSION OF SUPPLIERS

THE IIMP reserves the right to accept the participation of any SUPPLIER who DOES NOT meet the requirements set forth in the Supplier Regulations. For this purpose, the interested SUPPLIER must receive the relevant information from THE EXHIBITOR and must become acquainted with the conditions and guidelines set forth in these regulations to assess compliance with the requirements for approval and authorization to provide services at the Event.

7.1 RIGHT TO REMOVE THE SUPPLIER

THE IIMP may order the immediate removal of THE SUPPLIER or its personnel if they fail to comply with these Regulations or if their conduct poses a risk to the safety, order, or image of THE EVENT.

8.- STAND DESIGN AND ASSEMBLY

THE SUPPLIER must inform the PAVILION COORDINATOR daily and/or in a timely manner of any activities to be carried out, prior to their execution, for approval.

Bringing in materials for manufacturing structural elements such as beams, columns, or others is not permitted. Similarly, welding, spray painting, and related activities are also prohibited. These elements must be brought in PREFABRICATED, with only the following work permitted: installation using bolts, touch-ups, and furnishing.

The STAND should be designed and arranged with environmental and social considerations in mind to reduce its negative environmental impact and promote responsible sustainability practices, including reuse, recycling, circular design, or other strategies that promote resource efficiency and waste reduction.

All designs must comply with the Reglamento Nacional de Edificaciones (National Building Regulations - RNE).

The side walls of adjacent stands that have exposed structures or paneling, or that exceed the structure of the neighboring stand, must be finished with tensioned banners or smooth, plain, solid MDF in sober white. No design or decoration of any kind will be permitted in this area.

The structures and decorative elements must not exceed the dimensions of the acquired perimeter or its height projection.

If electrical power is required for the installation and dismantling stages, THE EXHIBITOR must request it from THE IIMP, which will assess feasibility and provide the additional cost information.

9.- DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

THE SUPPLIER, shall mandatorily submit a Third-Party Liability Insurance Policy endorsed to the IIMP.

THE SUPPLIER, shall mandatorily submit through THE IIMP's SYSTEM the technical file of the stand(s) to be assembled, which must include the following documents, depending on their complexity:

9.1.- STAND TYPE 1

DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED FOR COMPLEX STANDS (Stands taller than 3 meters)

- a) Architectural description (specifying the materials to be used), containing at least the information detailed in Annex 01. It must be signed by the person responsible for the design. (See Annex 01)
- b) 3D images and/or photographs of the stand structure.
- c) Descriptive report for structures and structural calculation (detail the structure material, the characteristics of the supports, joints, anchor points, etc.)
- d) Full distribution drawings signed by a licensed and qualified Architect
 - Architectural details, at an appropriate scale.
 - Construction details, at an appropriate scale.
- e) Structural drawings signed by a licensed and qualified Civil Engineer
 - Construction details, at an appropriate scale.



- f) Electrical drawings of the stand to be implemented, signed by a licensed and qualified Electrical Engineer (It must contain at least the load chart and single-line diagram according to the submitted plan.)
- g) Installation Responsibility Letter, signed by the installation supplier's legal representative. (See Annex 02)
- h) Structural stability certificate signed by a licensed and qualified Civil Engineer.
- i) Request for additional energy, if needed. (See Annex 03)

9.2.- STAND TYPE 2

DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED FOR SIMPLE STANDS (Stands that are NO taller than 3 meters)

- a) Architectural description (specifying the materials to be used), containing at least the information detailed in Annex 01. It must be signed by the person responsible for the design. (See Annex 01)
- b) 3D images and/or photographs of the stand structure.
- c) Complete, properly dimensioned layout drawings, signed by a representative of the installation company
 - For island-style stands on a 1/20 scale
 - Architectural details, at an appropriate scale.
 - Construction details, at an appropriate scale.
- d) Electrical drawings for the stands to be built, signed by a registered and licensed Electrical Engineer.
 - For island-style stands on a 1/20 scale
 - Single-line diagrams at the proper scale.
 - Detailed maximum demand table.
- e) Installation Responsibility Letter. (See Annex 02)
- f) Application for additional power, if needed. (See Annex 03)

9.3.- STAND TYPE 3

DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED FOR OCTANORM STANDS

- a) Architectural description (specifying the materials to be used), containing at least the information detailed in Annex 01. It must be signed by the person responsible for the design. (See Annex 01)
- b) 3D images and/or photographs of the stand structure.
- c) Installation Responsibility Letter. (See Annex 02)

The information to be submitted by THE SUPPLIER must be sent digitally through THE IIMP's SYSTEM.

To enter the venue, THE SUPPLIER must produce a hard copy of the dossier with the original signatures. Additionally, ALL installation suppliers must have another hard copy in their work areas for follow-up purposes and consultation by the IIMP.

THE IIMP shall review the documentation and express its conformity within a term of four (4) business days. Delays may occur, in which case this shall be notified by e-mail in advance. If a document is missing and/or has observations, the correction must be made through THE IIMP'S SYSTEM within a maximum of two (2) working days after the dossier is reviewed. Otherwise, THE SUPPLIER will not be permitted to start setting up and assembly work.



10.- SUBMISSION OF THE SUPPLIER'S PERSONNEL LIST

THE SUPPLIER shall be in charge of uploading the details of the personnel who will perform work during the installation, event, and disassembly phases onto THE IIMP's system no later than June 10, 2026, to check whether such personnel meet the requirements and to obtain the authorization for their free transit during the event and during module erection and dismantling. Foreign personnel, if any, must present their Foreign Resident Cards and work permit.

11.- UPON ENTRY OF THE SUPPLIER'S PERSONNEL

THE SUPPLIER shall send via THE IIMP's SYSTEM, the Supplementary Risk Work Insurance (SCTR) up to 72 hours prior to the start of its on-site activities and must also submit a hard copy upon arrival.

12.- UPON ENTRY OF TRANSPORTATION AND HEAVY-DUTY TRUCKS

THE SUPPLIER, must present their National Identity Document (DNI), the original waybill along with three additional copies, the vehicle registration card, proof of technical inspection, certificate of operability, a Complementary Risk Work Insurance Policy (SCTR), and driver's license.

THE SUPPLIER shall be directly responsible for ensuring that all heavy-duty vehicles are in proper working order and shall therefore cover the cost of any contingency.

13.- ENTRY OF MERCHANDISE

The merchandise (material, furniture, and equipment) may be entered according to the established schedule and timetables. The original waybill and three additional copies must be presented upon entry at Puerta Cero (Gate Zero) located on Av. Arqueología. The security personnel will review the merchandise and shall retain a copy of the waybill.

14.- ASSEMBLY DATES (ASSEMBLY AND DECORATION)

The merchandise (material, furniture, and equipment) may be entered according to the established schedule and timetables. The original waybill and three additional copies must be presented upon entry at Puerta Cero (Gate Zero) located on Av. Arqueología. The security personnel will review the merchandise and shall retain a copy of the waybill.

SUNDAY, JUNE 21, AND MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2026.

Assembly of stands with structural frames – Includes all types of vinyl applications

TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2026.

Hours for stand decoration: 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

For the placement of merchandising materials only.

All personnel entering the LCC facilities to work must have:

- Supplementary Insurance for Hazardous Work (SCTR), health insurance, and pension documents, which must be submitted in hard copy at Puerta Cero, located on Av. Arqueología. These documents must be pre-approved through the IIMP system.
- Waybill (in triplicate).
- Complete PPE sets appropriate for the work to be performed.

THE SUPPLIER must consider the internal dimensions of the stands when setting up and/or decorating them (see Annex 04).

The equipment or display items to be placed on the stand must not exceed 500 kg/m².

15.- IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF THE VENUE:

- All crew members and any other personnel entering the venue during the assembly period must complete the venue's mandatory safety orientation. Anyone who has not completed the orientation will not be permitted to enter the venue during the assembly period.

TECHNICAL MEETING.- The coordinator from the assembly company must attend.

SAFETY ORIENTATION.- ALL individuals who will participate in the assembly phase must attend.

LOCATION.- Lima Convention Center, Av. De La Arqueología, Puerta Cero (Gate Zero).

- Before the assembly begins, it is mandatory to have tarps, cardboard, plastic sheeting, rugs, or other protective materials in place to cover the entire floor area affected by the assembly. The same procedure must be followed during disassembly. If no protective materials are used on the floor, assembly or disassembly will not be permitted.
- To avoid scratching the floor, all components to be assembled must be placed on thick cardboard, carpet, or a protective mat before installing the structures. If installing vinyl flooring, a protective underlayment must be used to prevent scratches.
- It is not permitted to hang, nail, tape, staple, paint, drill, or attach any items to the walls, acoustic partitions, columns, panels, Octanorm structures, floors, or ceilings at the venue.
- It is not permitted to paint or weld materials used for stand construction within the venue.
- Exhibitors may not exceed the established dimensions of the stands.
- Compressors and small electric generators are not permitted.
- Any hand trucks used inside the Convention Center must have rubber wheels.
- The exhibitor will be held responsible for any damage to the venue caused by their supplier.
- The provider must submit their SCTR through the IIMP system.
- A Civil Liability insurance policy (endorsed to the IIMP) for 15,000 soles is required.
- If you require energy during assembly and/or additional power beyond what is provided at the event, you must request it from the IIMP. (See Annex 03)

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17.- INTEGRITY AND COMPLIANCE

THE SUPPLIER agrees to act in accordance with the principles of integrity, ethics, and transparency during its participation in THE EVENT.

In particular, it undertakes to comply with applicable laws regarding the prevention of corruption, money laundering, and terrorist financing, as well as with the IIMP's integrity policies.

It is prohibited to offer, solicit, or accept improper payments, benefits, or advantages in connection with the organization or conduct of THE EVENT.

Failure to comply with this provision shall entitle the IIMP to revoke the SUPPLIER's authorization to participate and order the immediate cessation of its activities.

18.- AMENDMENT TO THESE REGULATIONS

In order to comply with the provisions enacted by the Government of the Republic of Peru and as the organizer of the event, THE IIMP may amend these Regulations at any time, for which purpose it shall notify THE SUPPLIER in a timely manner.
