## PROCEDURE FOR MEDIA ACCREDITATION BEFORE THE PERUVIAN INSTITUTE OF MINING ENGINEERS (IIMP)

### ACCREDITATION CONDITIONS

All journalists applying for accreditation with the Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers (IIMP), as organizer of the event “15th International Congress of Prospectors and Explorers - proEXPLO 2026,” must submit accurate and truthful information to verify their authenticity and validity, including the following:

- A press ID card issued by the media outlet (print, digital, radio, or television; specialized or mass media relevant to the industry, the event, and of national interest) for which they work.
- An official letter bearing the media outlet’s letterhead.
- The registered corporate name of the media outlet (print, digital, radio, or television), indicating that it is a legally registered and active media company.
- Active Taxpayer Registration Certificate (*Ficha RUC*) of the media outlet.
- For Print Media:
  - The publication must have at least four (4) editions under the applicant’s authorship (2025-2026).
- For Television Media:
  - Continuous broadcasting during the six (6) months prior to the accreditation application (2025-2026) is required.
- For Radio Media:
  - Continuous broadcasting during the six (6) months prior to the accreditation application (2025-2026) is required.
- For Online Media (Digital Media), applicants must meet the following condition:
  - The online publication must have maintained continuous activity during the six (6) months preceding the accreditation application (2025-2026).
  - It must belong to a registered media company with a verifiable physical address outside the web environment, including a valid postal address and telephone number.
  - The publication must disseminate a substantial volume of original information, commentary, or analysis on national or international issues.
  - Social media profiles shall not be considered digital media outlets.

## **CLARIFICATIONS**

Accreditation shall be granted only to journalists who submit the required documentation in advance and whose affiliation with the registered media outlet is duly verified.

Journalists may be required to submit: the two (2) most recent issues of their publication, if they represent print media; recordings of two (2) recent feature segments, if they represent a radio station or television channel; one (1) letter from an audiovisual media outlet expressing its intention to broadcast their work, if they work for independent television production companies; original press clippings and photographs bearing the name of the publishing outlet, if they are photojournalists; or three (3) recent articles signed with their name, if they work for online media outlets.

The IIMP may request additional documented evidence to clearly establish applicants' credentials and verify their authenticity. Applications shall be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and the IIMP's decisions shall be final and not subject to appeal.

The Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers (IIMP) reserves the right to deny or revoke accreditation if applicants fail to provide truthful information or if their activities are contrary to the objectives of the event "15th INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PROSPECTORS AND EXPLORERS - proEXPLO 2026."

Journalists must begin submitting their accreditation applications as of Monday, April 6, 2026. The deadline for submission is Monday, April 20, 2026.
