REGISTRATION POLICIES proEXPLO 2026

ProEXPLO 2026, organized by the Instituto de Ingenieros de Minas del Perú (Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers - IIMP), is a leading international event for the mining industry. Within this framework, these Registration Policies are intended to establish the criteria and guidelines governing the participation formats, categories, and conditions.

These policies are designed to ensure orderly capacity management, the achievement of the event's commercial objectives, and its financial sustainability, while providing a transparent and efficient process for all participants.

Registration for proEXPLO 2026 implies the acceptance of the provisions set forth herein.

PARTICIPANTS

- The IIMP Associate who desires to benefit from the reduced rate must be current on all membership dues.
- Only one change of participant or category is permitted at no additional charge. Beginning with the second change, a penalty equal to 20% of the registration fee shall apply, subject to prior coordination and approval by the IIMP's Event Coordinator.
- To qualify for the student rate, the participant must be currently enrolled in a professional or technical degree program and be in the 7th through 10th undergraduate term (a certificate of enrollment from the university must be uploaded to the registration platform in PDF format, maximum file size 5 MB).
- To qualify for the faculty rate, the participant must submit a letter from the university where he/she works. Please note that the participant must be a full-time faculty member (a certificate of employment issued by the university must be uploaded to the registration platform in PDF format, maximum file size 5 MB).

CREDENTIALS

- Credentials are documents that identify the event participants according to their category and shall be subject to access control.
- In the event of loss or theft, a replacement credential shall be issued at a cost of USD 30.00.
- Credentials are personal and non-transferable, and must be worn visibly at all times during the event. The IIMP reserves the right to request valid identification from participants in order to verify the authenticity of the information provided.

Participant benefits

- Access to the conferences with simultaneous interpretation service (English - Spanish).
- Includes lunch (Only for Associate and Non-Associate categories)
- Access to presentations in PDF format of authorized conferences.
- Access to the Technical Exhibition.
- Participation in the opening and closing ceremonies. (Only for Associate and Non-Associate categories)
- Coffee breaks.
- Digital certificate of participation.

BILLING

- The participants must provide all the documents required to issue the respective invoice. Such documents may include, but are not limited to, the Purchase Order, if applicable, or any other document required for proper administrative processing.
- We recommend that participants provide accurate billing information as follows:
 - For companies: Company name, Tax ID Number (RUC), address.
 - For individuals: Full name, National Identity Card (DNI), address.
- For companies processing registrations through a Purchase Order, a fifteen (15) day credit term will be granted, subject to prior evaluation, so that full payment can be made no later than one day prior to the event.
- In accordance with institutional policy, changes to documents that have already been invoiced shall not be accepted. The billing information submitted in the registration form shall be honored as provided.
- Once the event has finished, no changes, claims, or credit notes shall be accepted with respect to invoices or receipts, unless an issue attributable to our system has occurred.
- Pursuant to internal policy, the 12% advance VAT withholding (detracción) shall be paid by the IIMP. Accordingly, the participant must deposit the full invoice amount to the designated accounts, and the Institute shall process the corresponding self-withholding (autodetracción).

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

- Refund requests shall only be accepted through March 31, 2026. A 25% penalty shall be deducted from the registration fee to cover administrative expenses. As from April 1, 2026, no refunds shall be made.

PAYMENT METHODS

Payment with Credit Card

- The IIMP accepts payments through NIUBI7 using credit and debit cards (domestic and international) from the following brands: VISA, MASTERCARD, AMERICAN EXPRESS, and DINERS.

- Card payments may be made through our website, as well as via a LINK payment option. The submission of the respective link can be coordinated with IIMP staff.

Account Deposit and/or Bank Transfer (Invoice required)

- Payments through BCP Bank:
 - Service Payment
 - Select the Institution: Instituto de Ingenieros de Minas del Perú.
 - Select the U.S. Dollar currency.
 - In the "Code" field, enter the participant's full name and National Identity Card (DNI) number, or the company's name.
- It is essential to complete these fields accurately when making the deposit in order to ensure proper identification of your payment. If payments are made from other bank entities, they must be processed as interbank transfers.

Only the amount credited to the Institute's bank accounts shall be recognized. Any bank fees or service charges imposed by the receiving financial institution must be borne by the participant and/or the company.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Online Registration

The standard registration process shall be conducted exclusively through the event's official web platform, where participants must:

1. Complete the registration form with their personal and professional information.
2. Select the appropriate registration category.
3. Upload the required documentation, if applicable.
4. Choose one of the available payment methods.

Registration shall be considered valid and confirmed only once the system has successfully recorded the information and the process has been completed in accordance with the established terms and conditions.

Individual and Corporate Registrations

- Individual Registrations

They refer to those completed personally by each participant. The participant is responsible for the accuracy of the information provided and for meeting the requirements applicable to the selected registration category.
- Corporate Registrations

They apply to companies or institutions registering two or more participants. They may be managed through a single administrative contact, who shall be responsible for:

 - Sending the list of participants.
 - Coordinating the verification of participant information.
 - Managing the corresponding payment in accordance with the previously agreed terms.

Registration and participation in proEXPLO 2026 implies acceptance of the Rules of Participation for proEXPLO 2026, available on the event's official channels.
