PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS 15TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PROSPECTORS AND EXPLORERS - PROEXPLO 2026

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

These Regulations govern the conditions for participation in and attendance at proEXPLO 2026 (hereinafter, the "Event"), organized by the Peruvian Institute of Mining Engineers (IIMP), and are mandatory for all participants, delegates, guests, sponsors, and exhibitors, as applicable.

II. VENUE AND DATE

The Event will be held in the city of Lima, Peru, from May 4 to May 6, 2026, at the Centro de Exposiciones Jockey.

III. PARTICIPANTS

Individuals and legal entities related to the mining, academic, professional, or institutional sectors, whether domestic or foreign, may participate, provided they complete the corresponding registration process and comply with these Regulations.

IV. REGISTRATION

4.1 Registration shall be carried out exclusively through the official channels enabled by the IIMP.

4.2 Registration shall be confirmed only upon full payment of the applicable fee.

4.3 Applicable fees, categories, and benefits shall be those published in the Event's official media and in force at the time of registration.

4.4 The IIMP reserves the right to validate the information provided by participants.

V. CREDENTIALS AND ACCESS

5.1 Credentials are personal and non-transferable.

5.2 Credentials must be worn visibly at all times during the Event.

5.3 Loss or improper use of credentials may result in their cancellation.

5.4 The IIMP may deny access to any person who does not meet accreditation requirements.

VI. PARTICIPANT RIGHTS

6.1 Access to Event activities in accordance with the category purchased.

6.2 Participation in conferences, technical sessions, and official Event activities.

6.3 Access to materials and certificates of participation, where applicable.

VII. PARTICIPANT OBLIGATIONS

- 7.1 Comply with these Regulations and with instructions issued by the IIMP during the Event.
- 7.2 Comply with the Code of Conduct established herein.
- 7.3 Properly carry and use the assigned credential and/or QR code.
- 7.4 Respect venue safety, health, and access control regulations.
- 7.5 Assume responsibility for personal belongings.
- 7.6 Provide truthful and up-to-date information during registration.

VIII. CODE OF CONDUCT

Participants must maintain respectful and professional behavior throughout the Event and refrain from actions that disrupt its normal development, affect other participants, speakers, exhibitors, or organizers, or violate safety rules or organizational guidelines.

Failure to comply may result in revocation of accreditation and removal of the participant from the Event without entitlement to a refund.

IX. SPONSORSHIP AND EXHIBITION

Sponsors and exhibitors shall also be governed by the proEXPLO Sponsorship and Exhibitor Participation Agreement and the corresponding Exhibitor Regulations.

X. MODIFICATIONS AND CHANGES

The IIMP may modify Event dates, program, content, or location for operational, technical, or force majeure reasons.

XI. CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

Applicable cancellation, change, penalty, and refund policies shall be those published in the Event's official media and in force at the time of registration.

The IIMP shall not be responsible for a participant's inability to attend the Event due to personal, professional, immigration, health, logistical, or other circumstances beyond the organization's control, including, without limitation, visa denial, flight cancellations, illness, or similar events. Such circumstances shall not entitle participants to refunds, compensation, or transfers, except as expressly provided in official policies.

XII. LIABILITY AND FORCE MAJEURE

The IIMP shall not be liable for losses, theft, damages, or harm suffered by participants or their personal property during the Event, nor for acts or omissions of third parties, nor for services provided by third parties unrelated to the organization.

XIII. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Personal data provided by participants shall be processed by the IIMP in accordance with applicable personal data protection regulations and its Privacy Policy, available through the Event's official channels.

XIV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND USE OF CONTENT

Event logos, trademarks, and materials are protected under applicable intellectual property laws. Their use, reproduction, or dissemination without prior express authorization from the IIMP is prohibited.

XV. IMAGE RIGHTS

Participants authorize the IIMP to record and use their image, voice, and/or name captured during the Event for institutional, informational, or promotional purposes related to the Event, in print and digital media, without entitlement to compensation.

XVI. PROGRAM MODIFICATIONS

The IIMP reserves the right to modify the Event program, including speakers, content, schedules, or activities, without generating any right to claims or refunds.

XVII. ORGANIZATIONAL AUTHORITY

The IIMP reserves the right of admission and continued attendance at the Event and may adopt any measures necessary to ensure order, safety, and the proper conduct of the Event, including the revocation of accreditation in the event of non-compliance with these Regulations.

XVIII. UNAUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES

The conduct of unauthorized commercial or promotional activities within the Event venue is strictly prohibited.

XIX. AMENDMENT OF THE REGULATIONS

The IIMP reserves the right to amend these Regulations and shall inform participants in a timely manner through official channels.

XX. ACCEPTANCE

Registration for and participation in the Event implies full and unconditional acceptance of these Regulations.

XXI. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

These Regulations shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of Peru. Any dispute shall be resolved by the courts of the judicial district of Lima, Peru.
